## DESCRIPTION

- a matting base designed to reduce the gloss level of Paracryl IF540 products

## PRINCIPAL CHARACTERISTICS

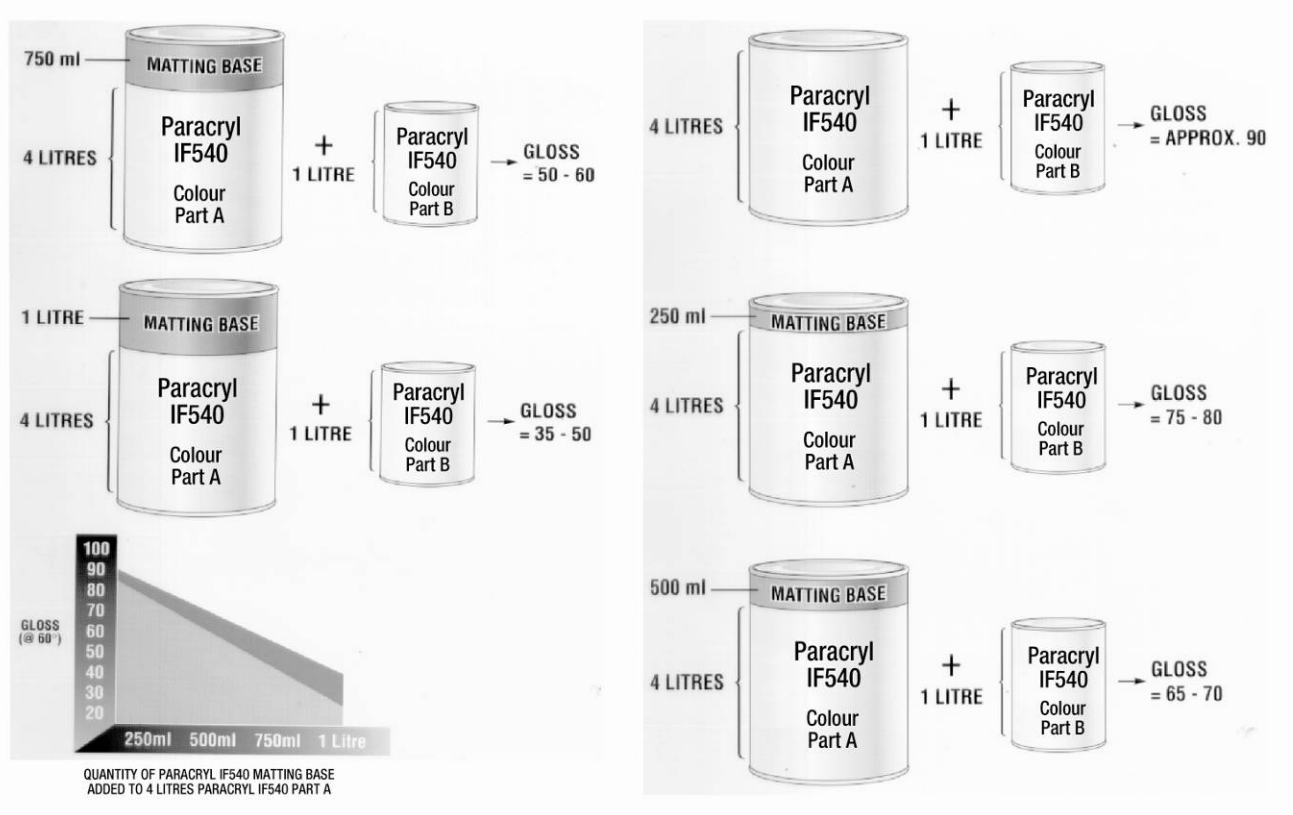
- specially formulated using the same durable resin system of the Paracryl IF540 range
- can reduce the gloss level of any Paracryl IF540 product - factory or tinted colours
- at the maximum addition rate of 1 litre Matting Base into 4 litre Paracryl IF540 Part A, low satin finishes can be achieved

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- the Matting Base should be stirred well before use to ensure good homogeneity
- add the required amount of Matting Base into the Paracryl IF540 Part A and stir in thoroughly
- mix this blend with the Part B as normal
- when high levels of Matting Base are used, less thinner may be required. Check consistency before addition of thinner
- the gloss obtained is influenced by thinner levels, application conditions and film thickness. Always check dried film gloss level on a sample panel before final use and preferably after 24 hours curing
- always seal the container of Matting Base when not in use to avoid drying out of the product
- refer to Paracryl IF540 Technical Data Sheet P52.01 for details on use
- use in Paracryl IF540 colours only. Not for use in Paracryl IF540 Antigraffiti Clear
- for recommendations outside those contained in this data sheet, refer to Wattyl
