SUBJECT: **Lead containing Paints**

Wattyl (NZ) Ltd has adopted the Wattyl Group-wide policy to cease manufacturing of all lead containing paints. This policy took effect from 1 December 2007.

The only products affected are specialist industrial products. Lead containing pigments were removed from paints sold to the retail market in the mid 1970's and lead containing driers, used in trace quantities in Enamel paints, were eliminated during 2001.

In the industrial market Lead containing pigments continued to be used to achieve economical bright and strong yellow and orange coloured paints with good opacity. In the case of Wattyl (NZ) Ltd these colours were supplied in Poly U 400, Industrial Enamels and Road Marking paints.

These colours can be achieved using non-lead containing pigments, but cost is up to 50% more, coverage is generally poorer and the colour is a metameric match (that is the colour is a match under some lighting conditions and not under others) to the lead containing formulation.

Wattyl believes the complete removal of paint containing lead compounds is a positive move for Wattyl staff, customers and the environment and whilst there will inevitably be issues during this transition, the benefits far outweigh the downsides.
