Painting Concrete Water Tanks

Concrete water tanks are commonly painted outside for appearance reasons using water based paints.

New tanks are commonly white washed or painted by the maker before delivery, and give many years service before painting is needed to restore their appearance.

When painting a tank, whether new or old, it is important to ensure the surface is properly cured and clean, i.e. no loose concrete, moss or lichen.

It is also important that the tank is empty!

The tank needs to be empty as water seeping through the walls will prevent any paint from drying properly.

Only pure 100% exterior acrylic paints should be used when painting concrete water tanks.
